

Using Respondus Lockdown Browser on a Chromebook

Installing LockDown Browser to a personal Chromebook

1. Log into the Chromebook and start Google Chrome
2. Go to the BSU download link for LockDown Browser (<https://download.respondus.com/lockdown/download.php?id=495635372>); you will automatically be redirected to the Chrome Web Store.
3. From the Chrome Web Store, select “Add to Chrome” to install the LockDown Browser Extension
4. Log into Blackboard with your BSU credentials and navigate to the exam that requires LockDown Browser
5. The LockDown Browser extension will be started automatically when an assessment requires it
6. Note: during the beta, this extension will only work with assessments an instructor has enabled for use with LockDown Browser for Chromebook

For a BSU-issued Chromebook, follow these instructions

1. Turn on the Chromebook but **do not login**
2. Click “Apps” on the bottom of the screen
3. Select Lockdown Browser
4. Type in Bridgewater State University when prompted
5. Log into Blackboard with your BSU credentials and navigate to the exam that requires LockDown Browser.
6. Note: during the beta, this extension will only work with assessments an instructor has enabled for use with LockDown Browser for Chromebook

Note: Students cannot use the Respondus Monitor on a Chromebook device; it is available for Windows, Mac, and iPad only.
